What's changing?

Bissell's Community Space is now operating as a low-barrier Service Hub, where housing, financial, and family supports are delivered in a more coordinated, person-centred way.

This continuity helps build stronger relationships and ensures no one falls through the cracks on their journey out of poverty.

Additionally, it will offer an opportunity to bring together other partners offering expanded services, providing more comprehensive support to members of our community.

Why does this change matter?

As our community's needs evolve, it's crucial we respond with effective programs that remove barriers and meet people where they are.

How will it affect the community?

As other organizations expand their capacity to meet basic needs, Bissell is focusing on longterm solutions that break the cycle of poverty.

Key supports—like housing, financial coaching, and family supports—are now

available in one place, with fewer barriers. And our collaborative approach with partner organizations means community members can access additional services.

We'll continue to offer referrals for urgent needs, while concentrating on the areas where we can make the most impact.
