Overview

Bissell Centre's Early Childcare Development Program offers full-time and part-time care for children ages 0-6, along with a respite program that provides free, temporary childcare for low-income families.

Qualifications

- Must submit a current criminal record with vulnerable section check. (A letter will be provided to obtain a police check after your volunteer application is complete)
- A willingness to learn about the inner city, its issues, and the workings of the Bissell Centre
- Demonstrate excellent communication, listening and interpersonal skills
- Be a team player and accept guidance from your supervisor
- Project and maintain a non-judgmental, empathetic attitude toward Bissell Centre community members.
- Respect the need for confidentiality
- Positive, enthusiastic, and friendly attributes are a must
- An openness to Bissell's core values and Key Practice Philosophies

Key Responsibilities

- Help with set up
- Meal services
- Child engagement
- Clean-up

Shifts/Time Commitment

- Choose a maximum of 1 four hour shift a day. No minimum requirement
- 2 shifts a day Monday – Friday to choose from
