

Food Services – Ongoing Group Volunteer Opportunity

Overview:

Our Food Services department will contribute to the elimination of poverty by removing barriers to distribution and providing daily access to essential and nutritious meal provisions that eliminate food insecurities.

Volunteers play an essential role in maintaining kitchen cleanliness and food safety standards.

Bissell's kitchen has the capacity for groups of **up to 10 people** at a time.

- No police check required
- Must be at least 14 years of age
- Must wear close-toed shoes

Shifts:

- Fridays 10am – Noon
- Other shifts can be arranged if needed by reaching out to the volunteer team at engagement@bissellcentre.org

Our commercial kitchen is located **Bissell Centre** Downtown East 10527 96 St. NW Edmonton, AB T5H 2H6 (The beige building with a bright yellow front door), and there is free parking on site.

Duties include deep cleaning, washing dishes, taking inventory, organizing food stuffs and supplies, receiving and sorting donations, etc.

Most kitchen duties are standing, and some involve lifting. The food services department is open five days a week.
