This role is ideal for volunteers who are hands-on, dependable, and motivated to make a tangible difference in their community.

Qualifications

- Must be at least 14 years old
- Friendly, self-motivated, and able to identify tasks with minimal supervision
- Physical ability to stand for half an hour

Key Responsibilities

- Cleaning, organizing shelving, inventory and washing dishes
- Receiving Donations
- Breaking down bulk food packages (grating cheese, repackaging, etc.)
- Chopping and general food preparation

Shifts/Time Commitment

- Shifts are 3 hours in length:
- 10:00 AM - 1:00 PM
- Available Monday through Thursday
- Volunteers may sign up for as many or as few shifts as convenient

Location

Training

- Volunteers receive a brief orientation before each shift.
- Once familiar with the space, volunteers will work independently with limited supervision. However, there is always help if you need it.
